ABORTION: A STATEMENT OF THE CATHOLIC BISHOPS.

Five years on from the May 2018 referendum which removed the constitutional guarantee of the equal right to life of unborn children and their mothers. Bishops of Ireland have issued a statement which also takes into account the review by Government of the abortion legislation introduced following the referendum. At that time the bishops said, "a new situation now exists in Ireland. It is essential for us as a Church, which cares passionately about the gift of life, and wants to support both mothers and their unborn children, to seek better ways of responding to this new and very challenging reality". Today, bishops reaffirm the deep conviction of our faith, namely that the dignity of every human life from conception to natural death, is a value for the whole of society, rooted in reason as well as in faith.

The bishops will continue to do their best to change the narrative through dialogue and by testifying, in season and out of season, to the Gospel of Life. How can people of Faith help?
